

The Old City of Jerusalem

Jerusalem's ancient walled city is roughly a kilometer (two-thirds of a mile) square and divided into Moslem, Christian, Armenian Quarter, and Jewish Quarters. On the eastern site of the Old City is the Temple Mount, on which is today placed the Al-Aqsa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock. The Temple's western retaining wall is considered holy by Jews, as the last remnant of the destroyed shrine.
