The Hula Valley is a restored wetland and nature reserve, famous for its role in global bird migration. Thousands of cranes, pelicans, and storks stop here each year. Once drained in the 1950s to combat malaria and expand farmland, parts of the valley were later restored to protect its unique ecosystem. Over 500 million birds migrate through the Hula Valley annually, making it one of the world's premier bird-watching sites. Rent a bike and explore the Hula Lake Park, stopping at observation points for breathtaking views.
