Banias, a major source of the Jordan River, features Roman temples, shrines, and scenic trails. The site was dedicated to the god Pan during the Hellenistic and Roman periods and later became significant in early Christianity. Banias boasts Israel's largest waterfall, a favorite for hikers. Stroll along the river trail, ending at the cascading Banias Waterfall. Treat yourself to a fresh trout at a restaurant set among the rapids.
