The Old City of Akko, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is a vibrant mix of history and culture, featuring Crusader halls, Ottoman-era fortifications, and a bustling market. In 1799, Napoleon's siege here was repelled by Ahmed al-Jazzar. Akko is home to Uri Buri, a celebrated fish restaurant.
